

How Do I Check MVP?

MVP, My Voter Page, is a portal maintained by the Georgia Secretary of State where you can access your personal voting information.




To log in, go to mvp.sos.ga.gov. Type in your first initial, last name, county where registered to vote, and date of birth, and press submit.


If you entered your information incorrectly, or if you are not registered to vote in the county that you selected at the MVP log in page, you'll get the following screen:

If you believe you are registered, go back and enter your information again.

It may take up to two weeks between when you register, and when you can access MVP.



If you entered your information correctly and you are registered, you'll see this:
